GRANT UPDATES

EWP- Construction is done on all projects; still waiting on NRCS reimbursements to pay contractors & engineers their final payments. Board may contact NRCS to ask why reimbursements are being held. Fromberg landowners are unhappy with the project. CCD is still inserting themselves into the issue even though they have no jurisdiction over EWP; it's causing a problem.

Mendenhall - Working on Final Report

Forestry Armstrong Creek – Just prior to the meeting our Admin received a call from the Ranger, The Ranger has had numerous requests from CCD and now from DNRC to see our Good Neighbor Agreement. They cannot give it to them without it being redacted. She will be telling them to request it from us. We have reservations about releasing the financial information in order to protect the integrity of the bidding process. There is no reason for CCD or NRCS to have this contract or have anything to do with the project. Project is sponsored by SCD & funded by the Forest Service. Ongoing issues with CCD inserting themselves into our projects. We need an outside party to look over the design and information to assess if it is feasible.

ARPA Danford/ARPA Orchard- Danford is in Construction; Orchard should be ready for bid next month with deadline for completion 12/31/2025.
